While we are not currently in session and debating bills, it's been a busy fall for the Legislature. Work has begun on many commissions and working groups to help us solve some of our statewide problems. Members have been appointed to groups addressing our long-term care workforce needs, transportation funding, mental health and much more.

There is also some work we need your help with today – voting. At the polls, you'll see two ballot questions that come from our work in the Legislature. The first asks if you'd like to authorize a \$105 million bond for transportation infrastructure projects, things like road and bridge repairs. The second question asks if you approve of allowing persons with physical disabilities to use an alternative method to sign initiative petitions, a process that's already allowed for things like registering to vote.
